


Welcome to Hankasalmi!

Hiker's Häähninmäki

A very high-quality and comprehensive trail network that attracts mountain bikers and hikers from all over Finland. There is a well-equipped unlocked hut and a cabin which can be reserved in advance along with campfire places. An observation tower, from the top of which, opens up an amazing view of the surrounding nature.

Häähninmäki offers new and unforgettable experiences for nature tourism.

The trail network is easily accessible by car, and the Häähntintuva area is within walking distance, therefore suitable for families with children. Häähninmäki is an ideal destination for many different types of camping all year round.

Also explore our other nature attractions, such as Keskisen Lampi, a protected pond area and a bird reservation area, which has a nature trail going around it. As part of the nature trail, there is a barrier-free access to a rest area which has a barbeque hut with a fireplace and a toilet facilities.

A resting place, which you won't forget, is Kalliolahti's lean-to on the shore of the clear waters of Armisvesi lake.

Craftsmen

Sepän Gallery is a unique place to visit. The pottery workshop and the shop are located in a wonderful location, in Poonala's old school. Sepän Galleria's beautiful and practical hand-made pottery, steel jewellery and interior design goods are great treats for you to take home or to give to someone else as a present.

At Sepän Galleria, you can take a peek at the production of clay pots - you can make your own clay cup as a souvenir.

During the summer, Sepan Galleria acts as an event venue, with its own exhibitions and concerts.

Appreciating heritage

Hankasalmi Museum Village takes you on a journey back in time. Hallan tupa has been renovated with great understanding of architectural traditions. Its courtyard buildings simulate authentic 17th-century Central Finland's living surroundings. The museum village and its courtyard buildings are maintained by the Hankasalmi home district association.

On a guided tour in the museum village, the buildings and objects get to tell their own stories about the life and customs of the past.

The museum village is a very popular venue for events and celebrations due to its unique surroundings. Many couples have had their wedding ceremonies at Hallan tupa and they have started their shared journey as a married couple from there.

The courtyard of the **Pienmäki House Museum** in Niemisjärvi breathes the unhurried atmosphere of old times. The area belonging to the Museum of Central Finland is a nationally important cultural environment. The museum's oldest log framed buildings are from the 18th century.

Hankasalmi's beautiful wooden church was designed by Josef Stenbäck. The church, completed in 1892, is a masterpiece of architecture and wood construction. The church has a wonderful acoustic and therefore its also known as a popular venue for high-level concerts.











Real rural life

Dig your toes into the soil and pat some calves! Hankasalmi farms invite you to get to know the authentic countryside. We have long traditions in farm tourism.

The cosy atmosphere and meeting the farm's animals is a memorable experience, especially for families with children.

In addition to accommodation and other services, the farms also offer direct sales to the public. Etelä farm is known for its honey, Rantakorven farm sells tasty lamb products, and from Niemelän farm you can buy not only lamb but also wool and other handcrafted products.

For those who dream of a cabin vacation, there are options for every taste. Both tourism companies and private individuals rent cottages.

Hankasalmi is also a horse stables and keen horse circuit. Pleasant riding moments are offered by Hankasalmi riding school in Kovalanmäki and Hirnuva Harmonia in Venekoski.





Experiences and places to visit

In Hankasalmi, the most memorable moments are experienced in the heart of nature. **Erä's Pete's** rapid fishing or kayaking trip, Voimanpesä's morning yoga and **LuontoViree's** soot pot coffees under the lyre tree, as a novelty the unique forest lodge Lumous. The atmospheric **Villa Mathilda**, operating at the former Sauvamäki village school, offers a good setting for courses or meetings, such as wild herb courses. In Kärkkäälä there is a **Hankasalmi Gluten-free products bakery**, whose delicacies you can buy and take away with you.

The Ruokoniemi campsite serves, not only for cabin and caravan lodgers, but also as a recreational spot for swimmers, exercisers and for social get togethers. Asema's second hand shop is a meeting place where there is a lively flea market, a cafe and an interior design store under the same roof. On the renovated **'Hangan Lava'**, you can dance to the rhythm of top artists on Friday evenings until the beginning of September.

Hankasalmi's specialty is northern lights and space research. The Hankasalmi observatory is located in the village of Murtoinen. That is where they record the cosmic noise of the northern lights. The observatory can be visited by appointment.

At Hankasalmi, the events are an inseparable part of the annual cycle. Highlights of the summer are for example **Heinäravit, horse race event,** at the Varnes-Hippos horse race track.

HankasalmiLive bring a vivid market atmosphere to the village market area.

At the end of the summer, during the harvest weekend, **several farms have an open day**. The August get together evening also offers a leisurely program for the whole family to enjoy.

In a playful **cycling event,** Asema village and kirkonkylä village, face each other in this good natured race between the two villages. In the summer, the event attracts a huge number of cyclists who take part in the race - others with a more casual approach and others with a more competitive view.

Venekoski's summer theatre performances offer a match for culture hunger. Lasten Festarit is a music event with accompanying programs aimed particulary at families with children.

Active associations and villages organise events around the area. Every year there is also something new


